



## **Agreement for General Academic Cooperation and Exchange**

*between*

College of Science and College of Engineering, Sungkyunkwan University,  
Republic of Korea

*and*

Faculty of Science and Faculty of Engineering, Chiang Mai University,  
Thailand



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The Faculty of Science and the Faculty of Engineering, Chiang Mai University and the College of Science and the College of Engineering, Sungkyunkwan University (hereinafter referred to individually as Party and collectively as the Parties) do hereby agree to promote cooperation and exchange in mutual beneficial areas of research and education.

### **Terms of Agreement**

#### **1. The Parties agree to the following**

a. The parties agree to develop and implement activities to facilitate the exchange of academic scholars and students. Such exchanges shall maintain an agreed-upon level of reciprocal parity.

b. The parties agree to exchange academic information, specimens, publications, and any other material of mutual interest. Such exchange will at all times be subject to the intellectual property laws pertaining in the country of each party.

c. The parties will develop joint academic and educational programs relevant to the progress of science and/or engineering in both Thailand and Korea.

d. The parties agree to the visitation of staff from the university of each Party pursuant to the development of and participation in academic and research programs and activities.

2. Proposals for joint activities, the publication of results, arrangements for visits and exchanges, and the extent of each Party's financial responsibility in a given activity, will be negotiated and agreed upon on a case-by-case basis, prior to the commencement of any activity. Final agreement for an activity will be recorded in the form of Addenda to this agreement.

3. The Parties agree to make every effort to seek funding for exchange activities. The Parties will at all times remain as autonomous bodies, under no financial obligation to the other Party in respect of their participation in this Agreement.

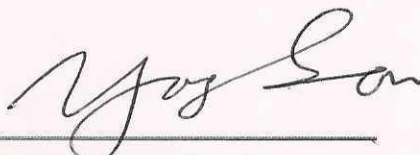
4. This Agreement will come into effect from the date of its co-signature by authorized representatives of the Parties and remain valid for five (5) years. It will thereafter be automatically renewed every five years unless either university notifies its intention of termination at least three (3) months prior to the expiration date.

5. This Agreement may be terminated subject to the tender and acceptance of written notice submitted at least six (6) months prior to the proposed date of termination. In the event of premature termination of this Agreement, all staff, scholars and/or students who have commenced

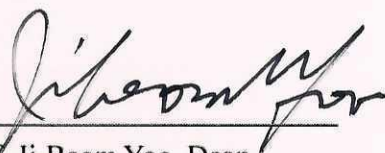
activities under this agreement will be allowed to complete the activities under the conditions applying at the time when the notice was accepted.

6. The English language version of this agreement is authentic, having been signed by the representatives of both Parties. A copy shall be retained by each institution.

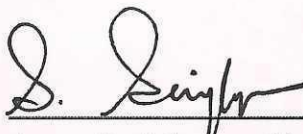

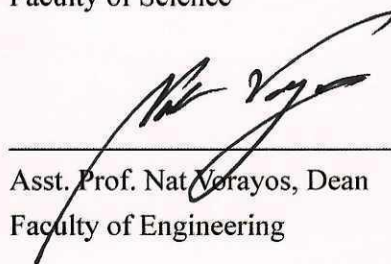

## Addenda

**Agreement for Research Collaboration and Dual Ph.D Degree Program**  
*between*  
College of Science and College of Engineering, Sungkyunkwan University,  
Republic of Korea  
*and*  
Faculty of Science and Faculty of Engineering, Chiang Mai University,  
Thailand

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The Faculty of Science and the Faculty of Engineering, Chiang Mai University (here in after referred as "CMU") and the College of Science and the College of Engineering, Sungkyunkwan University (here in after referred as "SKKU") hereby agree that cooperative research and academic exchange at the graduate level would be beneficial to each and intend to develop a joint program in a framework of agreement between CMU and SKKU. Therefore we plan to follow a protocol for agreement which was developed on August 25, 2011 as follows:

1. **Research cooperation** between professors and scholars at both institutions
2. **Exchanging students** who may take courses and/or carry out cooperative research
3. **Co-advising** of each exchange student, two research advisors, one from each institution
4. **Dual Ph.D. degree** if the students fulfill the degree requirements of both institutions.

The detail programs for implementation of this agreement will be discussed and agreed prior to commencement of the programs.

The agreement will come into effect on the date of signing by both parties and remain valid for five (5) years period from the date of signing. It will thereafter be automatically renewed every five years unless either university notifies its intention of termination at least 3 months prior to the expiration date.  
The agreement can be amended or terminated by mutual agreement of both parties.

Two (2) copies of the agreement will be signed in English, and both copies are equally valid.
